- **Stroke Center:** Providence Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital has been certified as an Advanced Primary Stroke Center since 2010. We are committed to providing immediate stroke care, with a team ready 24/7. The hospital treats ischemic strokes, hemorrhagic strokes and transient ischemic attacks (TIAs). Stroke services include AI-enhanced stroke detection software, state-of-the-art CT and MRI scanners, ultrasound, comprehensive radiology, stroke prevention and education services, and customized therapies.
- **Neurological Cancer Care:** For brain, cranial or spine tumors, Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital offers comprehensive care through its team of neurosurgeons and cancer doctors. The hospital provides advanced, high-quality cancer care, including systemic therapies like chemotherapy, clinical trials and immunotherapy.
- **Neurosurgery:** Recognized as a Blue Distinction Center for Spine Surgery by Blue Shield, Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital provides some of the most advanced surgical interventions for spine disorders. These treatments cater to adults of all ages and include minimally invasive spine surgery.
- **Rehabilitation:** Rehabilitation can help patients regain strength and skills lost due to brain or spinal injuries or conditions. We have Sonoma County's only hospital-based acute and neurological rehabilitation units, and we help patients improve their independence and live life fully.

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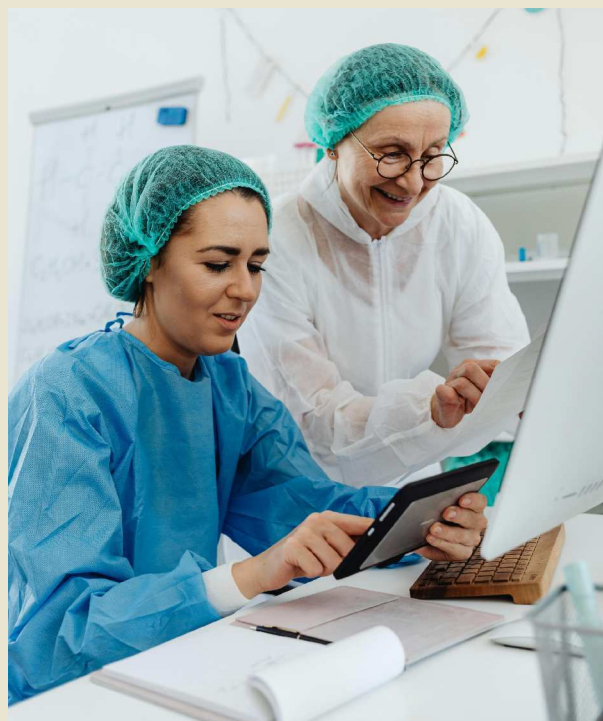
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How you can support brain and spine care
