- **Diagnostic Cardiology:** We offer state-of-the-art diagnostic procedures to aid in the evaluation, diagnosis and treatment of possible heart disease. Our specialized team and advanced technology ensure prompt diagnosis and effective interventions to improve patient outcomes and support recovery.
- **Advanced Heart Care and Surgery:** Offering advanced heart care and surgery means we provide 24/7 comprehensive cardiac emergency services with a highly skilled team, including heart surgeons and specialists. This ensures rapid response and complex treatment options for severe and life-threatening cardiovascular conditions.
- **Electrophysiology (EP):** Our EP Lab is one of the longest running and most highly experienced programs in Northern California for the evaluation and management of heart rhythm disturbances. Our dedicated and skilled EP team performs a range of specialized services, including EP studies, pacemaker and defibrillator implantations and ablation procedures. Santa Rosa Memorial is one of the first hospitals in CA to provide Pulsed Field Ablation (PFA) for atrial fibrillation (AFib).
- **Interventional Cardiology:** Our newly upgraded, state-of-the-art Cardiac Catheterization (Cath) Labs, equipped with advanced imaging technology, are used to pinpoint and diagnose problems with the function of the heart's muscles, walls and valves, as well as the coronary arteries that feed blood to the heart. The new Cath Labs at Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital are a game-changer for cardiovascular care in Sonoma County.
- **Structural Heart Program:** Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital's expert cardiac team uses the most effective therapies to treat patients with structural heart disease. Whether heart disease was present at birth or developed over time due to health conditions, our specialized team will provide you with whole-person, integrated care for your body, mind and spirit.
- **Vascular and Endovascular Services:** We provide comprehensive specialized care in diagnosing and treating blood vessel diseases and disorders. Our team of experts offer a range of open surgical vascular and minimally invasive endovascular procedures for diagnosis and treatment of heart disease

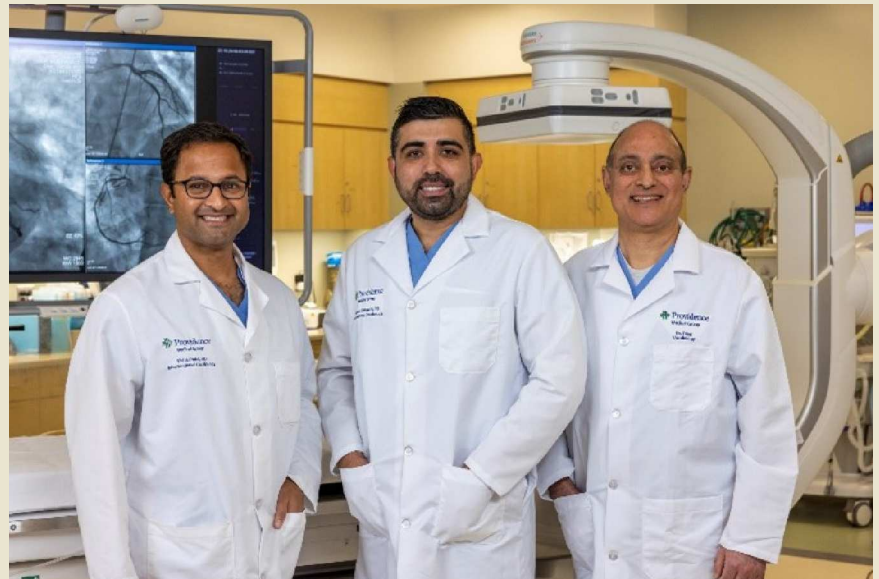
